Building a new home? **Fire Safety First**

When Faye was building her new home in Sydney, she carefully planned her home to not only be responsible for fewer greenhouse gas emissions by installing energy efficient appliances as well as an underground water tank, but she also considered her personal safety as well.

Being a Bilateral Cochlear Implant Recipient and having other hearing impaired family living with her, she thought of everything.

LIFESAVER®

She arranged an electrician to install a “Lifesaver (R) Professional 240V Smoke Alarm Model 4800RL” upstairs and downstairs in her new home, in addition to this, she carefully planned for each bedroom and living areas to be installed with “Lifesaver (R) 240V Remote Signalling Devices Model SL240” which interconnect with the Smoke Detectors and provide a bright 177 Candela Strobe Light.



240V AC Smoke Alarms

Having the Strobe Light signalling devices allows Faye to be woken up in case of a Fire emergency. All devices (Smoke Alarms and Strobe Lights) operate on mains power with lithium battery backup.



Visual Signalling Device

Faye can now sleep and rest assured that her personal safety comes first. So if you or someone you live with is hearing impaired, consider investigating what products are available to alert you of a fire in case of emergency. Life is precious!
